Park Square Theatre Launches New Out² Series for GLBT Audiences

Saint Paul, MN— As the Twin Cities’ only “pop and pop” theatre, Park Square Theatre is excited to launch **Out²**, a new series of performances and events for GLBT audiences. The series begins Friday, March 21, with a performance of Bryony Lavery’s Tony[®]-nominated play *Frozen*. Other shows in the series are *Lady Day at Emerson’s Bar & Grill* on Friday, April 25, and *Sherlock Holmes: The Final Adventure* on Friday, June 13.

Richard Cook, Park Square’s Artistic Director, and Steven Kent Lockwood, the Theatre’s Executive Director, are life partners of 33 years. Although not founders, both started as guest artists at Park Square in its inaugural 1975 season. “We know Park Square has many loyal fans in the GLBT community. We wanted to build on that energy by creating a ready-made ‘gay night out’ around one performance of each of our shows.”

Series tickets are \$89 for all three shows or \$28 per performance. In addition to saving over standard ticket prices, each performance features the added value of a different pre- and post-show event:

- ***Frozen***: pre-show director’s reception ; post-show cast party at Innuendo & Rumors
- ***Lady Day at Emerson’s Bar & Grill***: pre-show performance by Ovation (an ensemble from One Voice Mixed Chorus); post-show party at Townhouse with open mic night hosted by Lori Dokken

- *Sherlock Holmes: The Final Adventure*: pre-show reception , talk/book signing with Ellen Hart, Minnesota's leading GLBT mystery writer; post-show cast party at CAMP

Patrons who purchase an \$89 series ticket will also receive a \$20 gift card to their choice of the following restaurants: Meritage, Great Waters Brewing Company, St. Paul Grill or Kincaid's.
