



# Bringing fierce guitar playing and swing to gospel music, Sister Rosetta Tharpe was a legend in her time and a huge influence on Elvis Presley, Johnny Cash, Jimi Hendrix, and Ray Charles. *Marie and Rosetta* chronicles her first rehearsal with a young protégée, Marie Knight, as they prepare to embark on a tour that would establish them as one of the great duos in musical history. *Marie and Rosetta* premiered at the Atlantic Theater Company in New York City in August 2016 under the direction of Neil Pepe. The play won the 2016 Edgerton Foundation New Play Award.



**Playwright George Brant's** work has been developed and produced nationally and internationally. His most notable play, *Grounded*, opened at London's Gate Theater in 2013, followed by a Julie Taymor-directed/Anne Hathaway-acted production on off-Broadway at

the Public Theater in 2016. *Grounded* won the 2016 Lucille Lortel Award for Outstanding Solo Show, a Fringe First award at the 2013 Edinburgh Festival Fringe, and the 2012 National New Play Network's Smith Prize.
